

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YEAR 12 STUDENTS APPLYING FOR UNIVERSITY

If you are a year 12 student applying for university this year to start in Feb 2022, you need to ask help from your school to:

- apply as an 'International Student' - this means that usually the fees for your course could cost a lot of money, but some universities have special *Humanitarian/Asylum Seeker Scholarships* that can cover all these costs (the full tuition fees). This makes it possible for you to go university without paying fees;
- check that you make your course applications to those universities that offer *Humanitarian/Asylum Seeker Scholarships* scholarships that cover the full cost of the tuition fees (not all universities offer these). - make two applications to each of the universities to which you apply - *one for university course place* and *one for the special scholarships for asylum seekers* that cover the full cost of your International Student tuition fees (one off scholarships will not be enough);
- meet the key application deadlines for both your course and scholarship applications- they are different and vary across each university, so it is important to check each one. Applications for scholarships are open now.
